

## COPYRIGHT FORM AND COPYRIGHT NOTICE

IEEE policy requires that prior to publication all authors or their employers must transfer to the IEEE in writing any copyright they hold for their individual papers.

- When you access the EDAS platform to upload your final paper (click on the title of your paper), you will be prompted to transfer the copyright before submitting the final document. Click on the symbol beside “copyright form”. Then click on “IEEE Copyright submission” and follow the instructions and steps. Do not forget to sign (write your name) in the form (scroll down the window with the form to find the place where the name must be written). Finish the process (click “done”) and you will receive a copy of your copyright transfer agreement.
- The appropriate copyright clearance code notice is to appear on the bottom of the first page of each paper. You must include this code before uploading the final pdf file. The appropriate clearance code for this conference (IEEE Xplore document) is:
  - For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: **U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright**
  - For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is:

**978-1-5090-4837-3/17/\$31.00 ©2017 Crown**

- For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is:

**978-1-5090-4837-3/17/\$31.00 ©2017 European Union**

- For all other papers the copyright notice is:

**978-1-5090-4837-3/17/\$31.00 ©2017 IEEE**
